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DAY 1

Frankfurt Oder - Poznań (175 km, 2-hour drive)

The meeting point is scheduled for Wednesday's early afternoon in the center of Poznań. On that day in Poznań, we stay for the night, dinner and sightseeing. Poznań as the capital of the Wielkopolskie Voivodeship has a lot to offer. Visiting this beautiful city, we will have the opportunity to see the Old Market Square with the Town Hall, houses of builders and the Mielżyński Palace as well as the cathedral basilica in Ostrów Tumski, the Royal Castle and the Imperial Castle. In addition, we will taste some regional dishes in one of Poznań's restaurants.

DAY 2

Poznań - Gniezno - Biskupin - Bydgoszcz (160 km, 2-hour drive + sightseeing)

The next day, after breakfast in the morning, we set off at 9.30 am towards the first capital of Poland - Gniezno. On the Lech Hill in Gniezno, there is a gothic cathedral church, which has functioned as the main temple of the Gniezno metropolis since the year 1000. It is also the burial place of Saint Adalbert - the main patron of Poland, and the site of five royal coronations. From Gniezno, we go to one of the largest archaeological reserves in the world, located in Biskupin. Thanks to its exceptional value for the cultural heritage of Poland, it has been recognized as a Historical Monument. This discovery is among the 100 most important archaeological discoveries of the 20th century. Today, the reserve includes: reconstructions from the Bronze and Iron Age such as the camps of hunters and gatherers (in the form of visualizations), first farmers' settlements, a defensive settlement on the peninsula, box graves, and a Piast village. In the late afternoon we will get to the capital of the Kuyavian-Pomeranian Voivodeship - Bydgoszcz, where we stay for dinner and overnight. After checking in at the hotel, we will go on a trip along the Brda River to see some interesting parts of Bydgoszcz from the water side - Mill Island, Bydgoszcz Venice, the Bydgoszcz Cathedral, the Old Town, the Nova Opera building. For dinner we will be able to test a few traditional regional goose dishes.



Bydgoszcz - Luszkowo - Chrystkowo - Chełmno - Golub Dobrzyń - Toruń (157 km, 2h50 driving + sightseeing)

We start on Friday morning with breakfast and departure at 9 towards the Mennonite Chata in Chrystków. Chrystkowo is a settlement that was colonized in the 17th century by Dutch settlers belonging to the Protestant Mennonite sect. The interior of the 'Chata' is a living museum filled with old appliances, furniture and remains of mennonite tombstones. From the Chrystkowa Valley of the Lower Vistula we will reach Chełmno, where there will be a short coffee break. Chełmno is exceptionally rich in monuments, six gothic churches have been preserved here, the medieval urban layout is almost intact, as well as almost the entire perimeter of the city walls, the renaissance town hall, and many tenement houses, the oldest of which dates back to the 13th century. From Chełmno we will proceed to Golub - Dobrzyń, to visit one of the largest four-winged gothic - renaissance Teutonic castles. The final point of the day's program is a drive to Toruń, where we stop for dinner and overnight. Toruń with its medieval gothic Old Town, entered to the UNESCO World Heritage List and attracts crowds of tourists every year. Strolling through the streets of the Old Town complex, we will see the Leaning Tower, the Old Town Hall, the Monument of Nicolaus Copernicus, the Cathedral Basilica of St. John the Baptist and St. John the Evangelist, the House of Nicolaus Copernicus, the Monastery Gate or the Living Museum of Gingerbread.

DAY 4

Toruń - Inowrocław - Strzelno - Kórnik - Rogalin - Dakowy Mokre (220 km, 3h30 'drive + sightseeing)

On Saturday morning, after breakfast, we will leave Toruń at 9.30 am to the spa town of Inowrocław, to see one of the largest brine graduation towers in Europe. We will have the opportunity to breathe saturated air with aerosols for while walking around the spa park. Wielkopolska and Kujawy are regions with beautifully preserved palaces and noble manors. We will be able to visit some of them on this day, incl. the palace in Kórnik, Rogalin and the town of Dakowy Mokre. In the latter, we will have a farewell dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 5

On Sunday after breakfast we go home.
